

### Design Workshop:

The suggested workshop is part of the preparation phase for the 'Spend your Day in Khalifa' activities. The workshop contributes the following to the Citizen Participation in Historic Cairo research project:

- Public Housing: public space intervention.
- Historic Qasabas: linkage between al-Khalifa and Zaynhum Public Housing.
- Informal Settlements: use of public and open spaces for advocacy in al-Hattaba.

### Workshop Questions:

- 1- What are the intervention ideas best suited for the space?
- 2- How can these ideas be piloted, to be further studied?

### Workshop Structure:

- Day one: Introduction to the project, presentation and a tour of public housing in Historic Cairo.
- Day two: design working sessions, where participants are divided into groups.
- Day three: design working sessions, where participants are divided into groups.

### Target Group:

Total 30 architecture students from partner universities (Nile University, Alexandria University, and Suez Canal University) and 20 students from non-partner universities and young professionals. In Day 2 & 3 they will be split between three sessions:

- Public space intervention
- Linking al-Khalifa and Zaynhum
- Public and open spaces for advocacy

Workshop dates: 1- 3 of February 2019.

### About Citizen Participation in Historic Cairo:

The project aims to study certain aspects of Historic Cairo, registered as a UNESCO World Heritage site for its value as historic living city.

- Basics of urban management for heritage site with a focus on al-Khalifa Street.
- Al-Hattaba case study as an example of historic deteriorated neighbourhoods registered as informal settlements.
- Modern public housing projects within Historic Cairo.
